"Nice Venue"	Thank you! The volunteers on the association have worked hard with the council and the builders to make this the best it can be!

"Parking on Nicholson Park when the gates are closed is problematic"	The centre car park is due to have a restrictive barrier that will only be unlocked during the day/when there are bookings on. No cars relating to a booking should be parking on residential roads. At this time, we are unsure of the plans for the markings on the roads near the centre, and until they are adopted by the council, we can not provide an update on this. We continue to work with the Council to keep you updated.

"Restrict number of people for an event"	The hall has a capacity for the main hall (200) and the meeting room (22). We encourage all hirers to share lifts/walk/use other transport etc to ensure that the car park is sufficient for the booking. Although we do not have 100% control of the number of cars hirers bring along, we do ask this information beforehand in the Hiring Agreement and if the capacity is too high, we will discuss this with the hirer. We do hope though that the centres 52 spaces (and coach and disabled spaces) will be sufficient for the bookings we have lined up.
"Enforce a curfew for noisy activities"	The centres latest booking slot is up to 11pm (unless special consideration is given by the community association, where it may be open until midnight). We give guidance to bookers re: noise and to be considerate of neighbours. All bookings will be monitored to identify if there are any issues.
"Resident cards for discount/priority booking"	Residents of the Parks currently get a discounted rate for the main hall and meeting room. These rates can be found on the website: www.theparksca.org.uk
